On July 10, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the petition by Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated December 8, 1998, LS 9812084 PHM.

Based upon the board's review and consideration of the petition:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., is denied a three-month stay of the suspension of license #8239 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph. shall cause his counselor, Jack Weigman, CADC III to communicate to the board in writing the following:

1. Explanation of the process of urine collection for Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., to demonstrate and validate that it is random, as required by the *Order*.
2. Explanation of the basis of the statement contained in the June 28, 2001, correspondence from Mr. Weigman to the board that, "Mr. Iverson continues to follow the order of not drinking or using any mood altering drugs", given Mr. Iverson's February and April, 2001, positive urine screen test results.
