On June 13, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the petition by Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated December 8, 1998, LS 9812084 PHM. Also reviewed was the May 24, 2001, correspondence from the respondent's drug counselor, and a May 24, 2001, memorandum by the department monitor. The correspondence disclosed that the respondent was not submitting to random urine screens, and that one screen had tested positive, purportedly following a trip to Mexico.

Based upon the board's review and consideration of the petition and submitted documentation the board finds that the petitioner is not in compliance with paragraphs 2a and 2b(4) of the *Order*.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Roger G. Iverson, R.Ph., is denied a three-month stay of the suspension of license #8239 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.
