On February 14, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Craig W. Moon, R.Ph., for a three month stay of suspension and that the required monthly urine screens as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("*Order*") dated August 12, 1998, and paragraph 1 of the board's order of October 11, 2000, be reduced from eight to four, and that Moon be allowed to utilize his own designated witnesses for the witnessed collection of urine specimens required by paragraph 2b(4) of the *Order*.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the petition of Craig W. Moon, R.Ph., for a three month stay of suspension is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the request to reduce the required monthly urine screens as provided within the board's order of October 11, 2000, from eight to four, and that Moon be allowed to utilize his own designated witnesses for the witnessed collection of urine specimens required by paragraph 2b(4) of the *Order*, is denied.
