On April 10, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Craig W. Moon, R.Ph., for a three month stay of suspension and that the required monthly urine screens as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated August 12, 1998, and paragraph 1 of the board's order of October 11, 2000, be reduced from eight to four, and that Moon be allowed to practice as a pharmacist in charge in an amount increased from the current 16 allotted hours per week to an amount as deemed appropriate by the board.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the petition of Craig W. Moon, R.Ph., for a three month stay of suspension, and a reduction in the required monthly urine screens as provided within the board's order of October 11, 2000, from eight to six, is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the request that Moon be allowed to practice as a pharmacist in charge in an amount increased from the current 16 allotted hours per week, is denied.
