On December 11, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by William Karwoski, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated March 10, 1999, and to reduce or eliminate the counseling and drug screening requirements contained in the *Order*. On August 31, 1999, the board modified paragraph 2b(4) of the *Order* to require drug screening frequency of not less than twice every month while not practicing pharmacy. Mr. Karwoski is currently has not resumed the practice pharmacy. Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that William Karwoski, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license #9334 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin. The request for modification of paragraph 2b(4) of the *Order* is denied. Upon the resumption of the practice of pharmacy Mr. Karwoski is required to comply with the terms of paragraph 2b(4)(a) of the *Order* which requires a drug screening frequency of not less than eight (8) times per month for the first year following the date that he resumes the practice of pharmacy.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects, the previous orders of the board in this matter remain in full force and effect. Mr. Karwoski is advised that he must also comply with the terms of the board's order of March 22, 2000, following the resumption of the practice of pharmacy.
