On March 1, 2001, the board considered Ms. Loberg's petition for reinstatement of the license, along with a psychological assessment performed by Charles M. Lodl, Ph.D. Dr. Lodl's assessment recommends that Ms. Loberg re-enroll in a therapy program.

Based upon Ms. Loberg's petition, and other inofrmation of record herein, the board orders as follows:

#### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Linette K. Loberg, R.N., is hereby reinstated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Loberg's license shall be limited for a period of two years as follows:

- 1. Ms. Loberg shall participate in therapy with a therapist approved by the board, and on a schedule as determined by her therapist, to look at personality issues which contribute to her historical lack of judgment, her romantic involvement with the patient, factors leading to exacerbations in depression or anxiety, and to assist her in monitoring her alcohol usage.
- 2. Ms. Loberg shall be responsible for submission of quarterly reports prepared by her therapist setting forth her activities and progress in therapy, and from her nursing employer setting forth her activities and performance in her employment.
