On November 5, 1999, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require in part that within six months of the date of the Order, she complete an approved course in nursing ethics.

On March 6, 2000, the board considered Ms. Levelius' petition for an extension of time in which to complete the required coursework. The board extended the deadline for completing the course to December 31, 2000.

On February 2, 2001, the board considered information establishing that Ms. Levelius has failed to submit evidence establishing that she has completed the required coursework. Accordingly, and pursuant to paragraph 2.a. of the board's Order, the board orders as follows

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Catherine A. Levelius to practice as a professional Nurse in the State of Wisconsin is hereby suspended until such time as full compliance with the provisions of the board's November 5, 1999, Order has been attained.
