ORDER GRANTING

FULL LICENSURE

The Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter on September 15, 2000. By the terms of the board's Order, Dr. Stevens' license was suspended for a period of not less than one year. The suspension was stayed for three months with provision for consecutive three month stays upon compliance with certain limitations. Dr. Stevens was prohibited from engaging in conduct with a patient which is sexual or may reasonably be interpreted as sexual by the patient, was required to continue to receive therapy from a therapist satisfactory to the board, was required to practice under the supervision of another physician satisfactory to the board, and to practice only in a group setting satisfactory to the board.

On December 20, 2000, March 22, 2001, and June 20, 2001, the board granted Dr. Stevens' requests for further three month stays of the suspension.

On September 20, 2001, the board considered Dr. Stevens' request that all limitations on his license be terminated. Based upon that request, and upon all other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Mark K. Stevens to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin are terminated, and Dr. Stevens is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
