FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The respondent, Rebecca Bahr, RADC I,
 - a. is a WCB credentialed registered alcohol/drug counselor I (RADC I) and is paid to 10/25/2002;
 - b. was under WCB jurisdiction at the time of the alleged behavior, May 19, 2002, identified within the complaint;
 - c. received the complaint action on June 28, 2002;
 - d. did not respond to the complaint; nor to letters from the WCB Complaints Investigator dated August 19, 2002 and August 26, 2002; and
2. The respondent's last known address is 528-A Hickory St., Sheboygan, WI 53085.

CONCLUSION

As a result of the respondent's failure to respond to this complaint action, the Executive Committee concludes that the respondent, Rebecca Bahr, breached the following Rule contained within the *Counselor Code of Conduct* (Rev. 1996):

Rule 11.1 – A counselor shall cooperate in any investigation conducted pursuant to this Code of Conduct and a counselor shall not interfere with an investigation or a disciplinary proceeding or attempt to prevent a disciplinary proceeding or other legal action from being filed, prosecuted, or completed


DECISION
