On March 21, 2002, the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board issued an Order Adopting Stipulation in this matter and the Board issued a license with conditions to Dr. Bruesewitz. The condition on Dr. Bruesewitz's license required him to submit a current report of an independent mental health evaluation performed by a health care provider acceptable to the Board, to comply with any recommendations made in the report, and that he have no patient contact without prior approval of the Board.

Also on March 21, 2002, the Board received a one-page report from Mitchell Parchem, CSW, CADC III, CCS-G, who stated that he had conducted an AODA assessment of Dr. Bruesewitz on March 12, 2002, and issued a diagnosis of alcohol abuse - in full remission. Mr. Parchem did not recommend any further AODA treatment.

Therefore, the Chiropractic Examining Board approves the commencement of patient contact by Dr. Bruesewitz.
