FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Heath E. Colstad (Applicant) whose address is 440 Valley View Dr., Poynette, WI 53955 holds Conditional Private Security Permit No. 16490 which was issued by the State of Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing (Department) under a Stipulation and Order for Issuance of Conditional permit, a copy of which is annexed hereto.

2. The Order for Issuance of Conditional Permit includes the following provisions:

"The Applicant agrees to accept a conditional private security permit subject to the terms and conditions set forth below:

"1) The permit is conditioned upon successful completion of a FBI background search on the Applicant.

"2) Upon receipt of an adverse background report, the Department may, without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties issue an Order revoking the conditional permit. An Order issued pursuant to this paragraph will be sent to Applicant's mailing address, and a copy shall be sent to Applicant's Agency Employer. Applicant waives all rights to any appeal of a Department order revoking the permit if adopted pursuant to the terms of this paragraph."

3. The Department received a criminal history case summary from the Consolidated Court Automation Programs (CCAP), Wisconsin Circuit Court Access, updated on April 2, 2002, which indicates Applicant has been convicted of the following crime in the State of Wisconsin:

a. March 14, 2002 – Misdemeanor – Disorderly Conduct (Case #00CM000663)

b. March 14, 2002 – Misdemeanor – Bail Jumping (Case #02CM000041)

4. A copy of the criminal history case summary is attached.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

A. Under sec. 440.26(4m)b., Stats., a person who holds a license or permit issued under this section and who is convicted of a felony or misdemeanor, or is found to have committed a violation, in this state or elsewhere, shall notify the department in writing of the date, place and nature of the conviction or finding within 48 hours after the entry of the judgment of conviction or the judgment finding that the person committed the violation. Notice may be may by mail and may be proven by showing proof of the date of mailing the notice.

B. On the basis of the criminal history report described in paragraph 3. of the FINDINGS OF FACT, above, Applicant has been convicted of a misdemeanor in this state, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the private security profession. The Applicant also failed to notify the department of the misdemeanor conviction.

C Applicant is not eligible for a permit under sec. 440.26, Stats.

D. The Department has authority to issue the following Order under Chapter 440, Stats., and the provisions in the Stipulation and Order for Issuance of Conditional Permit.

ORDER

Now, Therefore, It Is Ordered That the Conditional Private Security Permit No. 16490 of Heath E. Colstad is REVOKED and Applicant Heath E. Colstad shall cease and desist from acting as a private security person and from engaging in private security activities in Wisconsin.

It Is Further Ordered That Applicant shall have an opportunity to challenge the accuracy of the information contained in the criminal history report described in paragraph 3. of the FINDINGS OF FACT, above by submitting information to the Administrator, Division of Board Services, P.O. Box 8935, Madison WI 53708-8935 within 10 days after the date of signing, below.

It Is Further Ordered That Revocation of the Applicant's conditional private security permit shall become effective on the tenth day after the date of signing, below.

It Is Further Ordered That Applicant shall immediately return the wallet size conditional private security permit and the 3 ½ x 5 ¼ wall certificate to the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Attention: Jan Bobholz, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.
