On December 4, 2002, the Social Worker Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board held a Class 1 hearing in this matter. Following presentations by Mr. Gaziano and Mr. Edwards, and after reviewing Mr. Gaziano's application file and supplemental information, the Section determined to issue the following order:

IT IS ORDERED that the application by Michael Gaziano for licensure as a Clinical Social Worker by reciprocity from Illinois will be treated as an application for licensure as a Clinical Social Worker by examination, and that the application will be granted upon his requesting, paying for, and passing the examination on Wisconsin Statutes and Rules, with the following limitation:

- For a period of two years from the date on which his license is granted, Mr. Gaziano may practice as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker only in a supervised practice setting.

- For a period of two years from the date on which his license is granted, Mr. Gaziano shall continue in therapy with a psychologist or a psychiatrist. The treating therapist may determine the nature and the frequency of therapeutic sessions.

- For a period of two years from the date on which his license is granted, Mr. Gaziano shall arrange with both his treating therapist and his employment supervisor to submit to the Social Worker Section semi-annual reports on his professional performance and his compliance with any therapeutic or employment requirements. The first report shall be due six months from the date on which his license is granted. These reports may be submitted to

- If any report informs the Social Worker Section that Mr. Gaziano is not completely capable of practicing safely, the Section may summarily suspend Mr. Gaziano's license until a hearing can be held on the summary suspension.

- If the preceding limitations are observed for a period of two years from the date on which his license is granted, and if during that time the Section receives no complaints or adverse reports against Mr. Gaziano, these limitations shall be removed and Mr. Gaziano shall be granted an unlimited license.
