ORDER GRANTING

On May 19, 2000, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that she complete six hours of training in nursing ethics, and that she be responsible for a period of one year following her reemployment as a nurse for submission of work reports prepared by her employer.

On May 2, 2002, the board considered Ms. Kozina's request for termination of all limitations on her license. Based upon evidence of Ms. Kozina's compliance with the limitations on her license, the board orders as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Mary M. Kozina are terminated, and Ms. Kozina is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
