On February 12, 2002, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the urine screen results of the respondent for the time period November 9, 2001 through January 22, 2002. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the previous order of the board reducing the required drug screens pursuant to the *Order* to 6 times per month, dated December 11, 2001, is revoked.
