ORDER GRANTING  
  
FULL LICENSURE

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On March 1, 2001, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to place restrictions on her practice, to require quarterly reports from her employer for one year, and to complete continuing education.

On April 4, 2002, the board considered Ms. Black's request that the limitations on her license be terminated. Based upon all information of record herein, including evidence that Ms. Black has fulfilled all the requirements imposed by her limited license, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Mary S. Black, RN, are terminated, and Ms. Black is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
