On January 8, 2002, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Jeffrey C. Verzal, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension of his license to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated November 8, 2000. Based upon the board's review of the petition and supporting documentation, on January 8, 2002, Jeffrey C. Verzal, R.Ph., was granted a one month stay of the suspension of license #8377 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin. It was further ordered that Jeffrey C. Verzal, R.Ph. was to provide written correspondence to the board for its next meeting on February 12, 2002, and explain why he cancelled appointments for collection of urine samples or otherwise did not provide urine samples as required by the *Order* for the months of August, September and October, 2001.

At its February 12, 2002, meeting, the board was presented evidence by the department monitor that Jeffrey C. Verzal, R.Ph. failed to comply with the board's January 8, 2002 order and had failed to provide written correspondence to the board as directed in that order.

Based upon a review of the evidence presented by the department monitor:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that the license to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, #8377, issued to Jeffrey C. Verzal, R.Ph., is hereby SUSPENDED.
