ORDER GRANTING  
FULL LICENSURE

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On April 6, 2001, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that she complete a course of training in nursing ethics, and that for a period of one year, she be responsible for providing quarterly work reports prepared by her employer.

On June 6, 2002, the board considered Ms. Earley's request that all limitations on her license be terminated. Based upon all information of record herein, including evidence that Ms. Earley has fully complied with the conditions placed on her license, it is ordered as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Tami M. Earley, RN, to practice as a professional nurse in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Earley is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
