ORDER DENYING
STAY OF SUSPENSION

On September 6, 2001, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order provided that respondent could apply for a three month stay of the suspension, and for successive stays of the suspension thereafter, upon submission of satisfactory evidence that respondent had fully complied with the terms of the board's Order during the preceding three month period.

On November 2, 2001, the board denied Mr. Thomas' initial request for a three month stay of the suspension of his license.

On January 3, 2002, the board considered Mr. Thomas further request for a stay of the suspension. Again, however, the board was confronted with evidence that Mr. Thomas is not fully compliant with his Order. Accordingly, it is ordered as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for a stay of the suspension of the license of Greg W. Thomas, RN, is hereby denied. Mr. Thomas may reapply for a stay upon submission of satisfactory evidence that he has fully complied with the board's Final decision and Order during the preceding three month period
