On November 28, 2001, the Department of Regulation and Licensing filed its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the Department ordered that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding be assessed against respondent. Pursuant to sec. RL 2.18 (4), Wis. Admin. Code, on or about December 4, 2001, the Department of Regulation and Licensing received the Affidavit of Costs in the amount of \$445.15, filed by Attorney Steven M. Gloe. On or about December 4, 2001, the Department of Regulation and Licensing received the Affidavit of Costs of the Office of Legal Services in the amount of \$159.09, filed by Administrative Law Judge John N. Schweitzer. The Department of Regulation and Licensing considered the affidavits of costs on January 10, 2002 and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$604.24, which is 100% of the costs set forth in the affidavits of costs of Attorney Steven M. Gloe and Administrative Law Judge John N. Schweitzer, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby assessed against respondent, and shall be payable by him to the Department of Regulation and Licensing. Failure of respondent to make payment on or before February 10, 2002 shall constitute a violation of the Order unless respondent petitions for and the Department grants a different deadline. Under sec. 440.22 (3), Wis. Stats., the Department of Regulation and Licensing may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credeatial to the respondent until respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.

To ensure that payments for assessed costs are correctly receipted, the attached "Guidelines for Payment of Costs and/or Forfeitures" should be enclosed with the payment.
