On September 25, 2002, the Physical Therapists Affiliated Credentialing Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's Order, respondent's license to practice as a physical therapist in Wisconsin was limited to require that within one year she complete three credits in physical therapy modalities, and four hours in patient rights. She was also required to successfully complete the Rehabilitation

Review procedure at the Department of Health & Family Services.

On May 7, 2002, the board considered Ms. Kiener's letter of December 21, 2001, by which she submitted evidence of completing the requirements imposed by the board's order. Based upon that evidence, the board orders as follows:

### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Tracy L. Kiener to practice as a physical therapist in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Kiener is hereby restored to full licensure.
