ORDER SUSPENDING THE LICENSE

Respondent

On October 4, 2001, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order provided that the suspension of her license be stayed for a period of three months. The Order also provided that respondent could thereafter request additional three month stays of the suspension, which would be granted upon submission of evidence of her compliance with the terms and conditions on the license. Included among these were that respondent participate in an approved drug and alcohol treatment program, that she participate in therapy at least once per week, and that she attend AA or NA on at least a weekly basis. Respondent was also required to participate in a drug screening program consisting of at least one screen per week.

On February 1, 2001, the board considered evidence that Ms. Miller has failed to comply with the terms and conditions on her license. Accordingly, and pursuant to the final provision of the board's Order, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Sandra L. Miller to practice as a practical nurse in Wisconsin is hereby summarily suspended. Ms. Miller may apply for reinstatement of the stay of the suspension upon satisfactory demonstration of full compliance with the board's October 4, 2001, Final Decision and Order during the preceding three month period.
