ORDER GRANTING PETITION

On March 1, 2002, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a practical nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order provided that respondent could request that the suspension of her license be stayed for a period of three months upon submission of evidence that respondent could safely practice as a practical nurse by submission of a satisfactory evaluation prepared by a health care provider acceptable to the board. The Order also provided that respondent could thereafter request additional three month stays of the suspension, which would be granted upon submission of evidence of her compliance with the terms and conditions on the license. Included among these were that respondent participate in an approved drug and alcohol treatment program if recommended by the evaluator, and that she participate in a drug screening program consisting of at least 52 screens per year. The Order also required that Ms. Schober pay the costs of the proceeding by July 6, 2002.

On March 13, 2001, the board granted Ms. Schober's request for a three month stay of the suspension of her license.

On July 11, 2002, the board considered Ms. Schober's request to permit her to pay the costs in installments of six monthly payments of \$200 and a payment on the seventh month of \$171.43. Based upon all information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that costs in this matter may be paid in seven installments according to the following schedule:

August 1, 2002	\$200
September 1, 2002	\$200
October 1, 2002	\$200
November 1, 2002	\$200
December 1, 2002	\$200
January 1, 2003	\$200
February 1, 2002	\$171.43
