ORDER GRANTING
STAY OF SUSPENSION

On March 1, 2002, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a practical nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order provided that respondent could request that the suspension of her license be stayed for a period of three months upon submission of evidence that respondent could safely practice as a practical nurse by submission of a satisfactory evaluation prepared by a health care provider acceptable to the board. The Order also provided that respondent could thereafter request additional three month stays of the suspension, which would be granted upon submission of evidence of her compliance with the terms and conditions on the license. Included among these were that respondent participate in an approved drug and alcohol treatment program if recommended by the evaluator, and that she participate in a drug screening program consisting of at least 52 screens per year.

On March 13, 2001, the board considered Ms. Schober's request for a three month stay of the suspension of her license. Based upon all information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license of Lynn Schober, LPN, is hereby stayed for a period of three months. Ms. Schober may petition for additional stays of the suspension, which shall be granted upon demonstration of full compliance with the terms and conditions of the board's March 1, 2002, Final decision and Order during the preceding three month period.
