ORDER DENYING EXTENSION

On February 1, 2002, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a practical nurse in Wisconsin was limited in part to require that she complete at least six hours of continuing education in the areas of patient charting and the legal aspects of nursing, and at least six hours of continuing education in the area of caring for patients with circulatory problems.

On November 7, 2002, the board considered Ms. Korytkowski's request for an extension in the deadline for completing the continuing education requirement. Based upon all information of record in this matter, including the fact that Ms. Korytkowski is not employed as a nurse at this time, and the fact that the deadline for completing the education is still almost three months from the date of the board's meeting, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for an extension of the deadline for completing the continuing nursing education required by the board's Order in this matter dated February 1, 2002, be, and hereby is, denied.
