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ORDER SUSPENDING THE LICENSE

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On March 1, 2002, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, Ms. Marshall's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited for an indefinite period. The Order provided that respondent could not practice under her license in any facility licensed by the Department of Health & Family Services until having completed a rehabilitation review by that department. Thereafter, Ms. Marshall's practice was to be restricted to supervised settings, not including employment as a pool nurse, visiting nurse or other home care practitioner. She was also required to provide for quarterly work reports from her employer and, within six months, complete 12 hours of therapy or other training in anger and stress management, and six hours of continuing education in elder care and management of difficult patients.

On October 4, 2002, the board considered evidence that as of the date of the meeting, Ms. Marshall had not submitted evidence of having complied with any of the terms of the board's Order. Accordingly, pursuant to paragraph # 13 of the board's Order, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the limited license of Barbara A. Marshall, RN, is hereby suspended.
