On March 1, 2002, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter, by the terms of the board’ Order Ms. HaLsne was required within one year from the effective date of the Order to submit proof of conducting at least three presentations of nursing staff in-services acceptable to the Board on subject areas which include but were not limited to: charting, legal aspects of nursing, and caring for patients with circulatory problems.

In the alternative, Ms. Halsne could submit within one year from the effective date of the Order documentation of successful completion of at least twelve hours of continuing nursing education approved by the Board in the subject areas of patient charting and legal aspects of nursing and six hours in caring for patients with circulatory problems, or in other areas approved by the Board.

On October 4, 2002, the board considered evidence of Ms. HaLsne’s compliance with the board’s Order. Based upon that evidence, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Catherine A. Halsne, RN, to practice as a professional nurse in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Halsne is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
