The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about August 13, 2001, Amy M. Veith submitted an application for a Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology manager's License. Attached to this document as Exhibit A is a true and correct copy of the application materials that Respondent submitted to the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board.
2. Respondent falsified the Employment Verification of Hours information that she submitted to the Board in conjunction with her application.
3. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board issued Respondent a Manager's license (#28846) on 11/09/2001, based in part upon the falsified information it received in conjunction with Respondent's application.
4. In resolution of these proceedings, Respondent consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to above, Amy M. Veith has violated sec. 454.15(2)(a), Wis. Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that

1. Respondent shall **SURRENDER** effective immediately her Barbering and Cosmetology manager’s license (license #28846). Respondent shall immediately return to the Board all license cards, certificates and/or other indicia of licensure for her manager’s license.

2. Ms. Veith shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a FORFEITURE of FIVE HUNDRED dollars (\$500.00). Payment shall be submitted as follows:

- a. \$100.00 due on or before May 15, 2002;
- b. \$100.00 due on or before June 15, 2002;
- c. \$100.00 due on or before July 15, 2002;
- d. \$100.00 due on or before August 15, 2002; and
- e. \$100.00 due on or before September 15, 2002.

3. Payment shall be made by certified check or money order, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

4. In the event Amy M. Veith fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the practitioner's license of Respondent SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Amy M. Veith has complied with the terms of this Order.

5. If Ms. Veith in the future applies for a Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology manager’s license, Respondent shall provide include independent verification acceptable to the Board of the Respondent’s work hours submitted in support of her application. Independent verification shall be provided at Respondent’s expense. The Board in addition may in the exercise of its discretion require a personal appearance by Ms. Veith to answer questions in conjunction with her application.

6. This Order shall become effective on the date of its signing.
