ORDER GRANTING STAY

On June 6, 2002, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order provided that respondent could petition for a three month stay of the suspension at any time, with further provision for her petitioning for additional stays conditioned upon respondent's compliance with certain conditions and limitations on her license. Included among these were that respondent participate in an approved drug and alcohol treatment program, and that she participate in therapy at least once per month.

On October 4, 2001, the board considered the fact that Ms. Stoehr's three month stay was expired, and that she had failed to petition for a further stay. Accordingly, the license was suspended.

On November 7, 2002, the board considered Ms. Stoehr's request for reinstatement of the stay. Based upon all information of record herein, it is ordered as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license of Catherine A. Stoehr, LPN, be, and hereby is, stayed for a period of three months.
