Accordingly, the Board in this ma	tter adopts the at	tached Stipulation and makes the following:

1. Pamela M. Iczkowski (D.O.B. 02/10/48) is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a registered nurse (license # 48983). This license was first granted on September 16, 1968.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 2. Respondent's latest address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 3741 Division Road, Jackson, WI 53037.
- 3. During 2001, Respondent was on medical disability. In order to receive insurance benefits Respondent was required to have her physician submit a signed "attending physician's progress statement" monthly, indicating whether the patient remained disabled, or was released to return to work. Respondent was totally disabled, but rather than obtain her physician's statement and signature, Respondent forged the attending physician's progress statement and signature on five occasions.
 - 4. Respondent is not currently employed as a nurse.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct described above, Pamela M. Iczkowski is subject to disciplinary action against her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 441.07(1)(b) and (d), and Wis. Adm. Code sec. 7.04(6) and (8).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Pamela M. Iczkowski is REPRIMANDED.
- 2. The license of Respondent to practice as a nurse in the state of Wisconsin is LIMITED as follows:
- a. Respondent shall certify to the Board the successful completion of an approved course of training in nursing ethics, within 9 months of the date of this order. Within 2 months of the date of this Order, Respondent shall submit to the Board designee an outline of the required training for approval, which shall contain the name of the institution providing the instruction, the name of the instructor, and the course content.

Failure by Respondent to fully and timely comply with the requirements of this Order shall result in the suspension of Respondent's license to practice as a nurse without further notice or hearing, until such time as full compliance with the provisions of this Order has been attained.

- 3. The rights of a party aggrieved by this Decision to petition the Board for rehearing and to petition for judicial review are set forth on the attached "Notice of Appeal Information".
 - 4. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
