#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Robert E. Wallace, (Applicant) whose address is 2723 N 26<sup>th</sup> Street, Milwaukee, WI 53206 holds Private Security Permit No. 9223 which was issued by the State of Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing (Department) under an Application For Private Security Permit, a copy of which is annexed hereto.
- 2. The Department received information from the Wisconsin Department of Justice Crime Information Bureau and the Milwaukee County Clerk of Court's office which indicates the applicant has been convicted of the following crimes in the State of Wisconsin:
  - a. January 2, 2002 Felony Vehicle Operator Flee/Elude Traffic Officer Count 1 (Case #01CF005863)
  - b. January 2, 2002 Misdemeanor Operating While Intoxicated Count 2 (Case #01CF005863)

A copy of the convictions is attached hereto.

- 3. Documentation on file establishes that you have been convicted of misdemeanor and felony crimes, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the private security profession.
- 4. Documentation on file establishes that you have been convicted of misdemeanor and felony crimes, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the private security profession.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

A. Under sec. 440.26(5m)2., Stats., an individual who has been convicted of a felony in this state or elsewhere and who has not been pardoned for that felony is not eligible for a permit under sec. 440.26, Stats
B. On the basis of the criminal history report described in paragraph 2. of the FINDINGS OF FACT, above, Applicant has been convicted of a felony is this state and has not been pardoned for that felony.
C. Applicant is not eligible for a permit under sec. 440.26, Stats.
D. The Department has authority to issue the following Order under Chapter 440, Stats., for Issuance of a Private Security Permit.
<u>ORDER</u>
Now, Therefore, It Is Ordered That the Private Security Permit No. 9223 of Robert E. Wallace is REVOKED and Applicant Robert E. Wallace shall cease and desist from acting as a private security person and from engaging in private security activities in Wisconsin.
It Is Further Ordered That Applicant shall have an opportunity to challenge the accuracy of the information contained in the criminal history report described in paragraph 2. of the FINDINGS OF FACT, above b submitting information to the Administrator, Division of Board Services, P.O. Box 8935, Madison WI 53708-8935 within 10 days after the date of signing below.
It Is Further Ordered That Revocation of the Applicant's private security permit shall become effective on the tenth day after the date of signing, below.
It Is Further Ordered That Applicant shall immediately return the wallet size conditional private security permit and the 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ wall certificate to the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Attention: Jan Bobhol: P.O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.
