The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Dennis L. Davis (dob: 10/22/53) is and was at all times relevant to the facts set forth herein a licensed practical nurse licensed in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to license #33177. This license was first granted 8/3/95. Respondent previously participated in the Impaired Professionals Procedure of the department, and successfully completed the IPP in August, 2001. Respondent participated in the IPP because he had been diverting controlled substances from his employing nursing home, Pine Valley Manor.

2. Between March 30 and April 18, 2002, and while employed as a nurse at the Good Samaritan Home in Fennimore, WI, Respondent diverted the controlled substances oxycodone and hydrocodone, by falsifying patient records, for his personal use.

3. Respondent has asked to unconditionally surrender his license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

A. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to §441.07(1)(b)(c) and(d) Wis. Stats. and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to §227.44(5), Wis. Stats.

B. The conduct described in paragraph 2, above, violated § N 7.03(2) and N 7.04(1), (2) and (15) Wis. Adm. Code. Such conduct constitutes unprofessional conduct within the meaning of the Code and statutes.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the SURRENDER of the license of Dennis L. Davis to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the state of Wisconsin is ACCEPTED .

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
