ORDER DENYING
FULL LICENSURE

On September 6, 2001, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that within 90 days, she complete the U.W. Nursing School program entitled "Legal Issues for Nurses in Today's Health Care Environment." Ms. Milan was also required to provide quarterly work reports from her nursing employer for a period of one year, and to submit within six months documentation of her knowledge of patient rights.

On March 1, the board considered Ms. Milan's petition for return to full licensure. While it appears that the required coursework has been completed, the other requirements set forth on the board's Order have not been. Accordingly, it is ordered as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the petition of Francine Milan for reinstatement of full licensure is denied.
