On May 14, 2002, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Marilyn L. Kuhrt for a continued three month stay of suspension as provided in the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated April 1998. ("Order") . Ms. Kuhrt also sought further modification of the *Order* to reduce her therapy sessions with her counselor as required under paragraph 2 b (2) of the *Order* to (4) four times per year. Her counselor and supervising physician requested that the requirement of paragraph 2 b (2) be eliminated in its entirety.

Based upon a review of the petition and supporting documentation submitted:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Marilyn L. Kuhrt, R.Ph., is GRANTED a three month stay of the suspension of license #9781 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for a reduction in the frequency of therapy sessions is granted, and accordingly individual/group therapy sessions with a therapist as required under paragraph 2 b (2) of the *Order* are terminated. Ms. Kuhrt shall continue to meet with her supervising physician (4) four times per year.
