

WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF REGULATION & LICENSING



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On August 20, 2002, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by David L. Kleingartner, R.Ph., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated June 10, 1998. A request was also made for an (8) eight hour increase in the number of hours worked per week as a pharmacist in charge (currently at 24 hours per week) and that the frequency of therapy sessions required under paragraph 2 b (2) of the *Order* be reduced to one time every (60) sixty days.

Based upon the board's review of the documentation submitted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that David L. Kleingartner, R.Ph., is GRANTED a three month stay of the suspension of license #8865 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that an (8) eight hour increase in the number of hours worked per week as a pharmacist in charge (currently at 24 hours per week) is granted for a total of (32) thirty two hours per week allowed as a pharmacist in charge; and that the petition to reduce the frequency of therapy sessions required under paragraph 2 b (2) of the *Order* is granted, to one time (ix) every (60) sixty days.
