On January 8, 2002, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by John R. Litzenberg, R.Ph., for a three month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("*Order*") dated August 12, 1998, and that he be allowed to work an additional eight (8) hours per week as a pharmacist in charge. Pursuant to a modification of the *Order* dated July 10, 2001, Litzenberg currently is entitled to work a maximum of twenty-four (24) hours per week as a pharmacist in charge.

Based upon the foregoing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that John R. Litzenberg, R.Ph., is granted a three month stay of the suspension of license number 10410 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to work an additional eight (8) hours per week as a pharmacist in charge is denied.
