On September 10, 2002, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Andrew P. Rice, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated September 21, 1999, and that he be allowed to work an additional (4) four hours per week as a pharmacist in charge and be allowed to either open or close the pharmacy. Rice currently is allowed to work (8) eight hours per week as a pharmacist in charge and may not open or close the pharmacy.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Andrew P. Rice, R.Ph., is granted a three month stay of the suspension of license #9594 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petition for (4) four additional hours worked per week as a pharmacist in charge is granted, for a total of (12) twelve hours per week. Rice may either open or close the pharmacy, but not consecutively.
