ORDER GRANTING PETITION

On June 27, 1996, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's surrender of his license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was accepted by the board. By the terms of the stipulated order, respondent agreed never to reapply for a license to practice medicine and surgery in this state.
At its meeting of June 25, 1997, the board considered a written petition by Dr. Rochon for reinstatement of a limited license to practice i Wisconsin, . Dr. Rochon appeared before the board in support of his petition on that date, and the board denied the petition by its Order dated July 7, 1997.
Dr. Rochon again petitioned for reinstatement of a limited license by his letter dated February 1, 2000, and he again appeared before the board in support of his petition on February 24, 2000. At that time, Dr. Rochon indicated that if granted such a license, his intent was to pursue admission to a postgraduate training program at either the PG-1 or PG-2 level. On March 3, 2000, the board issued its Order Granting Limited License, by which Dr. Rochon was granted a license limited to require that he practice medicine and surgery only as a participant in a residency program, and requiring that he not practice medicine and surgery other than as a participant in that residency program.
On December 20, 2000, the board granted Dr. Rochon's petition for a modification in his limited license to permit him to practice as a medical review officer. The Order specified that Dr. Rochon be responsible for submission to the board of quarterly reports from the residency director if practicing as a participant in a residency program, and quarterly reports from his employer if practicing as a medical review officer. The Order also continued the requirement that Dr. Rochon remain in therapy and be responsible for submission of quarterly reports from his therapist.
On March 19, 2003, the board considered Dr. Rochon's request that the requirement for quarterly therapy reports be terminated. Based

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the limitation on the license of Gary R. Rochon, M.D., requiring that he be responsible for submission of quarterly reports from his therapist is hereby terminated.
