On April 9, 2003, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Mark G. Anderson, R.Ph., for a three month stay of suspension a required by the board's *Final Decision and Order*, ("*Order*") dated August 9, 2000.
