On March 5, 2003, the State of Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by James Scott Markenson, D.D.S., for a three-month extension of the stay of suspension, as provided in the Board's *Final Decision and Order* dated May 3, 2000. Dr. Markenson also requested a change in his therapy sessions and in his drug monitoring.

Based upon the Board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that James Scott Markenson, D.D.S., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of License #3132 to practice dentistry in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Markenson may participate in monthly, individual counseling sessions in lieu of group therapy.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Markenson's request to change the protocol for his urine screen samples is DENIED.

Please be advised that the next submission of reports and the petition for an extension of a stay of suspension are due on May 15, 2003.
