ORDER REINSTATING FULL LICENSURE

On May 19, 2000, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin was limited for a period of one year to require that within six months of the date of the Order, she complete eight hours of continuing education or therapy in the area of stress/anger management, and eight hours of continuing education in the area of elder care. On January 5, 2001, the board considered evidence of respondent's failure to complete the continuing education and/or therapy within the required time, and considered as well Ms. Hoitink's implied request that she be granted an extension of the deadline for completing the requirements. The board did not grant the extension, and remanded the matter back to the Division of Enforcement for further possible action.

On June 6, 2003, the board considered Ms. Hoitink's request for termination of all limitations on her license. Based upon all information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Mary Ann Hoitink to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Hoitink is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
