On June 1, 2001, the Board of nursing entered its Final decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's Order, Ms. Reisimer's license was limited to require that she participate in a mental health treatment program, and to participate in individual or group therapy sessions on a schedule as recommended by her supervising therapist. She was also required to arrange for quarterly reports from her supervising health care provider, and to practice only under the supervision of another registered nurse.

On November 7, 2003, the board considered Ms. Reisimer's request to reduce the number of therapy sessions with Dr. Lamberton, her psychiatrist, to once quarterly. Based upon all information of record herein, it is ordered as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the frequency of therapy sessions with Dr. Lamberton is hereby reduced to one per quarter. The frequency of Ms. Reisimer's therapy sessions with Dr. Schneider shall remain unchanged
