On June 19, 2003, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Michael J. O'Kray, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order*, ("*Order*") dated July 11, 2000, case number LS 0007112 PHM., and a request that the drug screening required by paragraph 2b(4) of the *Order* be reduced to four times (4x) per month. O'Kray is currently at eight urine screens per month.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Michael J. O'Kray, R.Ph., is granted a three month stay of the suspension of license #9415 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the request that the drug screening required by paragraph 2b(4) of the *Order* be reduced to six times (6x) per month, is granted.
