On December 10, 2003, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Michael J. O'Kray, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order*, ("*Order*") dated July 11, 2000, case number LS 0007112 PHM., and a request that the required drug urine screens be reduced from six to four times per month. The request was unsupported by his therapist or supervising physician.

Based upon the board's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Michael J. O'Kray, R.Ph., is granted a three month stay of the suspension of license #9415 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the request that the required drug urine screens be reduced from six to four times per month is denied.
