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ORDER MODIFYING LIMITATIONS

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On May 3, 2001, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require in part that within six months of the date of the Order, Ms. Lange complete an approved course of training in medication administration and documentation. The Order also limited Ms. Lange's license to require that she refrain from access to or administration of controlled substances in her employment setting.

On August 2, 2001, the board considered evidence that Ms. Lange has in fact had access to and has administered controlled substances in the course of her employment, in violation of the board's Order. Accordingly, the board imposed the suspension.

On November 1, 2001, the board granted Ms. Lange's request for reinstatement of her limited license.

On July 11, 2002, the board considered Ms. Lange's request for reinstatement to full licensure. The board denied the request, but removed the limitation by which she was required to refrain from access to controlled substances.

On August 8, 2003, the board considered Ms. Lange's renewal of her request for termination of all limitations on her license. Based upon all information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Ms. Lange's request that all limitations on her license be terminated is granted, and Ms. Lange is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
