ORDER RESTORING FULL LICENSURE

On May 2, 2001, the Dentistry Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the Board’s Order, the Respondent’s license to practice dentistry was limited as follows: Dr. Rater was required to provide quarterly reports from his probation officer. He was also required to attend an educational program at Marquette University School of Dentistry. Additionally, he was ordered to refer all patients presenting with a diagnosis of Acute Necrotizing Ulcerative Gingivitis to an independent practitioner for a confirmatory diagnosis and treatment. Finally, Dr. Rater’s practice was required to be monitored for a period of not less than twelve months. The Order further provided that upon a showing by Dr. Rater of his compliance with those conditions that he would be eligible for the return of his full license.

On May 7, 2003, the Board reviewed the request of Stephen W. Rater, D.D.S., for the return of his dental license without restrictions pursuant to the Board’s *Final Decision and Order* dated May 2, 2001. Therefore, based upon that request and upon evidence of Dr. Rater’s compliance with the terms and conditions on his license,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all the limitations on the license of Stephen W. Rater, D.D.S., to practice as a dentist in Wisconsin are lifted and he is restored to full licensure.
