On September 9, 2003, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the petition by Arthur H. Hackendahl, R.Ph., license # 6715, to remove the limitation on his license to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin as follows: *Respondent shall not be responsible for any step described in § Phar 7.01(1), wis. Adm. Code, with respect to any prescription drug or device for himself or any member of his immediate family or his household. Respondent may receive a written prescription from his own prescribing health care provider, and provide that prescription to another licensed pharmacist for dispensing.* This limitation was imposed pursuant to a Final Decision and Order, dated August 14, 2001, ("Order"). Based upon a review of the petition:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that the petition is granted, and Arthur H. Hackendahl, R.Ph., license number 6715, is restored to unlimited licensure to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin, with all right and privilege appurtenant thereto.
