By its Final decision and Order dated November 1, 2001, Ms. Buck's license to practice as a registered nurse was limited for a period of one year, to require that she continue successful participation in a treatment program for her mental health condition her supervising therapist shall determine to be appropriate for respondent's rehabilitation. Such treatment was to include at least one counseling session per month. Respondent was to abstain from all personal use of controlled substances as defined in sec. 961.01(4) Stats., except when necessitated by a legitimate medical condition, and was required to abstain from all personal use of alcohol. The supervising health care provider was to submit written reports to the Department assessing Respondent's progress in treatment.
After one year of continuous active professional practice under the Order without violation of the terms thereof, all limitations were to be terminated and an unlimited license was to be restored.
On August 8, 2003, the board considered Ms. Buck's petition for termination of all limitations on her license. Based upon all information of record herein, the board orders as follows:
<u>ORDER</u>
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Kelly Rene Buck, RN, to practice as a professional nurse in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Buck is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
