On September 10, 2003, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the request by Blair D. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Moldenhauer shall attend self help meetings on a weekly basis.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Moldenhauer’s license to practice dentistry remains subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Board’s *Final Decision and Order* dated January 9, 2002.

Please be advised that the next submission of reports and the petition for an extension of a stay of suspension are due on November 15, 2003.
