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ORDER GRANTING STAY OF SUSPENSION AND MODIFYING LIMITATIONS

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On March 1, 2002, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order stayed the suspension for three months and provided that Ms. Silver's could petition for further three month stays, which would be granted upon submission of evidence of her compliance with the terms and conditions on the license. Included among these were that respondent participate in an approved drug and alcohol treatment program, that she participate in counseling at least once per month, and that she participate in a drug screening program consisting of at least 26 screens per year.

On June 6, 2002, and again in September and November, 2002, the board granted Ms. Silvers' requests for further three month stays of the suspension.

On March 7, 2003, the board granted Ms. Silvers' request for a further three month stay of the suspension, and her further request that the number of therapy sessions be reduced.

On September 5, 2003, the board considered Ms. Silvers' requests that she be granted a further stay and that the number of required urine screens be reduced. Based upon all information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license of Lana L. Silvers, LPN, be, and hereby is stayed for a further period of three months. Ms. Silvers may apply for further three month stays, which shall be granted upon submission of satisfactory evidence that Ms. Silvers has fully complied with the board's Order during the preceding three month period.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the number of required urine screens is hereby reduced to five each quarter.
