The Board of Nursing filed its Final Decision and Order in this matter on March 1, 2002. Under the terms of the board's Order, Ms. Kramer's license was limited to require that within twelve months from the effective date of the Order, Respondent submit documentation of successful completion of at least six hours of continuing nursing education approved by the Board in the subject areas of patient charting and legal aspects of nursing and six hours in caring for patients with circulatory problems, or in other areas approved by the Board
Additionally for a period of at least one [1] year from the date of the Order, Respondent was required to arrange for quarterly reports from her nursing employer(s) reporting the terms and conditions of her employment and evaluating her work performance.
On June 6, 2003, the board considered Ms. Kramer's request for termination of the limitations on her license. Based upon all information of record herein, the board orders as follows:
<u>ORDER</u>
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Concepcion Kramer, LPN, to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Kramer is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
